### **Shire of Harvey to receive funding to enhance Brunswick Townsite**

The member for Murray-Wellington Murray Cowper has welcomed the State Government's announcement of \$5.97 million for major regional infrastructure projects in Western Australia.

A total of 14 infrastructure projects will benefit from the funds, which have been allocated under the State Government's Regional Infrastructure Funding Program.

Mr Cowper said he's extremely pleased \$344 548 in funding will go towards the initial stage of the proposed 'Mooseum' project in the Brunswick Junction Townsite.

The funding will assist the Shire of Harvey with the civic enhancement program which will include a caravan rest area, a picnic and children's play area and a dairy hall of fame.

"The dairy industry has been synonymous with the town of Brunswick for many years. The small community is proud of the importance it plays within WA's economy, and it's pleasing it's being recognised with this funding for the initial stage of the "Mooseum Project".

Mr Cowper commends the Brunswick Junction Town Centre Redevelopment Advisory Group and The Shire of Harvey for their initiative with this project.
